ltem Number	Item Name	Description
1.	Search field	Click to search by resident name or case number.
2.	OVERVIEW and	Click the Overview tab to view details about COVID-19 cases across your organization.
	DASHBOARD tabs	Click the Dashboard tab to view details about infection cases across your organization.

ltem Number	Item Name	Description
3.	Etiology column	 Shows where the infection was acquired. House icon - Acquired in house. Building icon - Present on admission.
4.	Status column	 Shows the status of an infection case. Confirmed (P) - Confirmed by the provider. Confirmed (D) - Confirmed by diagnostics.
5.	Onset date column	Shows the onset date of the infection. For example, the date the symptoms started or the date of a positive diagnostic test.
6.	Evaluation column	Click to attach or view evaluations. For example, the Respiratory Infection Screener.
7.	Diagnostic order column	Click to attach or view diagnostic orders. For example, an order for a chest x-ray.
8.	Pharmacy order column	Click to attach or view pharmacy orders. For example, an order for an antibiotic.
9.	Filter and export icons	Click the filter icon to select filters. The filter lists are based on the selections in the existing cases. For example, if Viral is not selected in a case, then Viral does not appear in the Infection type filter list. Click the export icon to download the information on the
		screen to a CSV file. You can open the CSV file in another application, such as Excel.
